The District responds to roughly 1400 calls per year with 80% of requests for service being medical in nature. Much of the District is located within the Wildland Urban Interface and has a significant wildland fire history. The District is heavily involved in community events such as the Sisters Rodeo, the Sisters Outdoor Quilt Show, and the Sisters Folk Benefits Festival. The region is well known for our year-round outdoor recreational opportunities.
